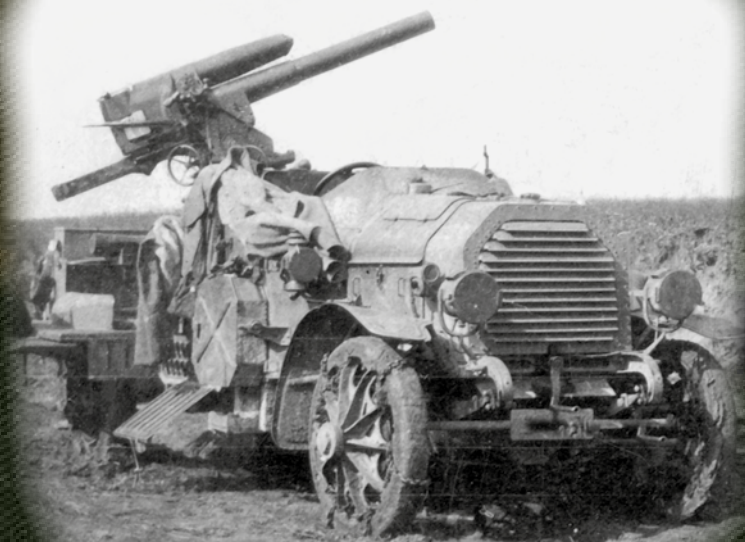

Previously, the Soviet KV (Kliment "Klim" Voroshilov) series of heavy tanks was described in many Western sources as being a slow and cumbersome sidekick to the T-34, and that it had only limited influence on combat during Operation Barbarossa, the German invasion of the Soviet Union in 1941. However, based on the most recent research, such a view can no longer be considered feasible today. Over recent years, the author has undertaken a completely updated and unbiased assessment of the KV and its true role on the battlefields of the Eastern Front. Analysing new findings, it can now be claimed with certainty that the KV's legacy has been severely underestimated. Consequently, this book is the author's fully updated and completely fresh take on a legendary Soviet tank design that came as a total surprise to its enemies, which slowed down the German advance under the most adverse circumstances and to such a degree that it laid the foundation for Soviet victory four years later.

The author goes as far as to say that the KV's role on the Eastern Front of 1941 had, in many respects, similar tactical and emotive impacts on the enemy as the German Tiger tank did on the Western Allies in Normandy in 1944.

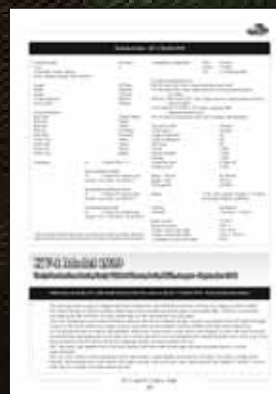
This comprehensive publication provides fully updated research on the KV family of tanks, development of its prototypes and pre-series vehicles, the series production batches and its deployment in combat, as well as correcting previously published mistakes. Many new findings are illustrated in astonishing hitherto unknown detail and include new variants that are shown for the very first time. An additional and extensive chapter also rewrites the story of KV tanks serving in the German Wehrmacht as KW Beutepanzer.

In 728 pages, supported by 1,030 wartime photographs, 204 other black&white photographs, 345 2-D and 3-D graphics, as well as 18 1/35-scale 5-perspective line drawings plus 32 colour plates and graphics and 45 colour photographs, this is the first ever extensively visual coverage of a tank design that has lived far too long in the shadow of the T-34. The "Klim Voroshilov" tank family can now finally take its deserved place alongside the defenders of the Soviet motherland in 1941 and in world tank history.

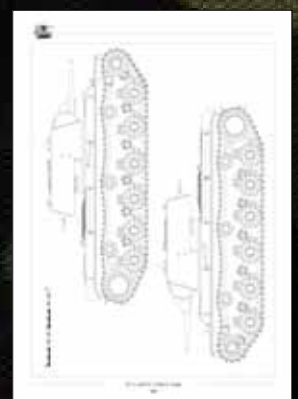
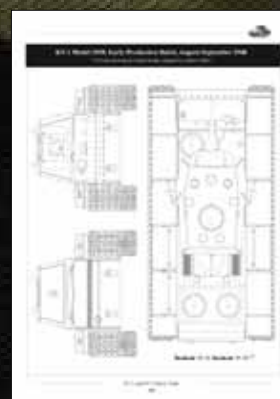

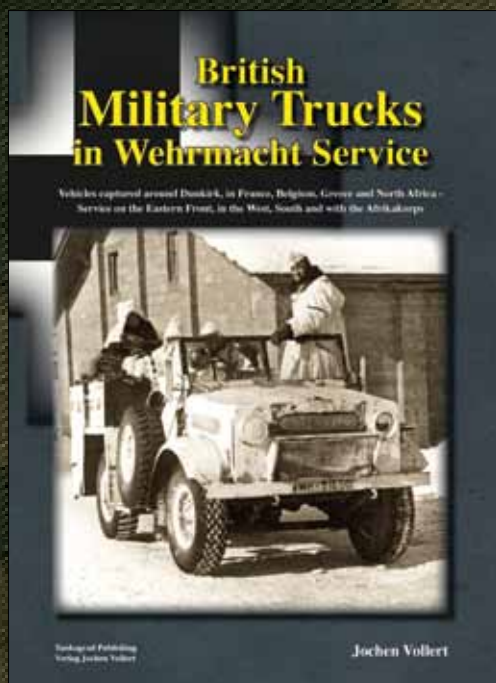
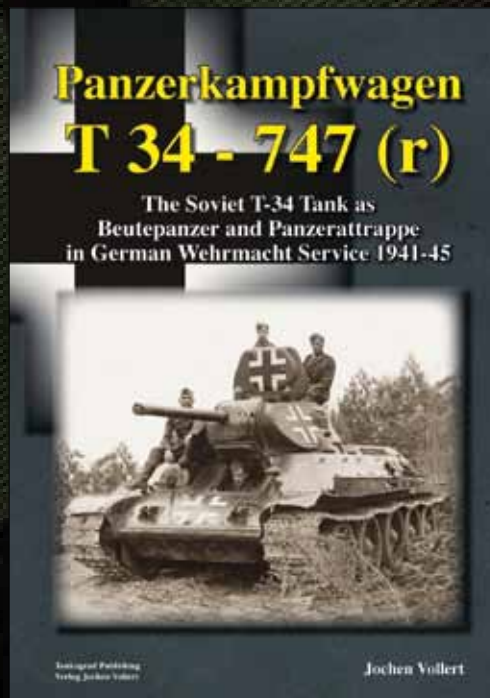
Beutepanzer, captured foreign tank designs in service with the Wehrmacht, played a much more influential role in German Panzer deployment and tactics than previously thought. While the bulk of Beute tanks were relegated to hinterland policing and anti-partisan duties, it was the hundreds of Soviet-built T-34s in German hands that were supporting Panzers in the medium tank and tank destroyer roles in combat everywhere along the frontlines in the East.

For the first time, this book sheds comprehensive light on the German Panzerkampfwagen T 34 - 747 (r), and underlines this detailed research with hundreds of photographs of the German T 34 in action. Unlike other publications so far released on the topic of Beutepanzer, this monograph focuses on the hardware rather than on the organisational paperwork of unit designations, readiness reports and unit deployment histories. It is consequently highly pictorial, showing tanks in service, their Soviet technology and production batches, as well as their German modifications and markings and it looks at the life of their crews. Furthermore, it outlines the T-34's development in the Soviet Union based on the most recent discoveries. As it is crucial to understanding the astonishing extent to which the T-34 was used in German service, and what an immense and important impact it had, the background of the German Beute principle is highlighted in an extended introduction.

Another major chapter in this book is devoted to T 34 Panzeratrappen dummy tanks that, to a hitherto unknown degree, were most influential in tactical anti-tank training and tactical doctrine for the Wehrmacht. The extent to which these T 34 dummies were used strongly underscores the thundering impact this Soviet medium tank had on the German side. The Panzeratrappen require a similarly extensive introduction in this book. Dating back to Kaiser and Reichswehr days, it allows readers to fully understand why 'wooden T 34s' played such a decisive role in German land warfare training.

British Military Trucks in Wehrmacht Service

Vehicles captured around Dunkirk, in France, Belgium, Greece and North Africa - Service on the Eastern Front, in the West, South and with the Afrikakorps

Captured Beutefahrzeuge of British manufacture were a significant addition to Germany's military efforts in the later war years. Without these trucks, many stemming from the Battle of Dunkirk, the German war machine would have been much less capable of waging Blitzkrieg against the Soviet Union from 1941.

While Operation Dynamo, the evacuation from Dunkirk in May and June 1940, made possible the escape of more than 300,000 French and British soldiers, they had to leave all their heavy equipment behind. All in all, the BEF lost around 65,000 vehicles, many of which returned to military service on the German side and doing their duty on the Eastern Front. Other sources for the German Wehrmacht to lay its hands on British trucks to supplement its own forces were Operation Demon in April 1941, the British evacuation from Greece, and the campaign in North Africa from February 1941 to June 1943.

This publication offers for the very first time a comprehensive overview on the various British Trucks in Wehrmacht Service, covering well-known models and makes such as the Bedford and the Morris-Commercial GS trucks in the 8cwt to 3-ton range, the heavy Scammell Pioneers and AEC Matadors, specialised vehicles such as cranes and field cars as well as many rarer makes, rarities and oddities.

A special chapter also grants an overview on the Canadian-built vehicles of the British Army that served with the Afrikakorps.

For all British military vehicle enthusiasts this book is a milestones.

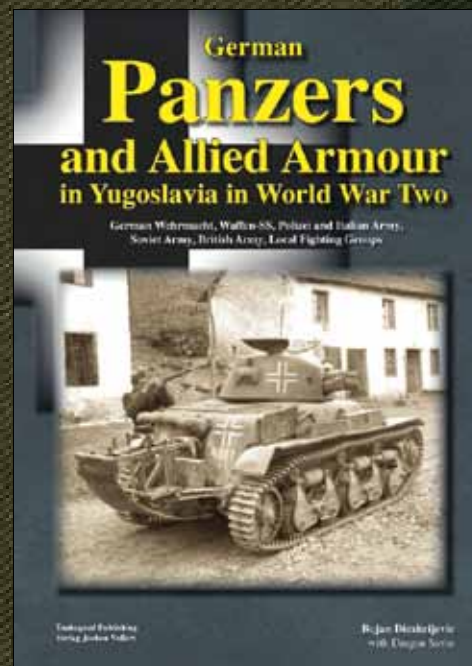

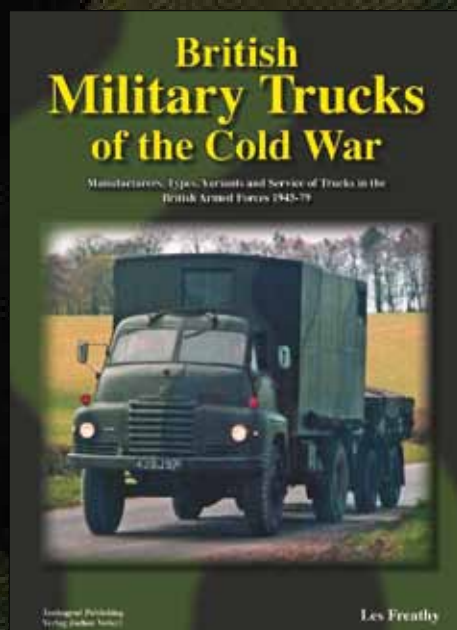

The end of hostilities in 1945 left the British forces with a massive surplus of military vehicles placed throughout the many countries involved in the conflict. Much of this equipment after six years of war was in a very poor state of repair, and a lot was only fit for scrapping. The development and use of military trucks in the post-war period was therefore dominated by the feverish search for the ideal military vehicle.

Moves had been made between the War Office and British manufacturers to produce a family of standard types to avoid the logistical nightmare that had occurred during the war with so many different makes. This search for much more suitable tactical-truck designs in the early 1950s created a period that was brimming with new ideas.

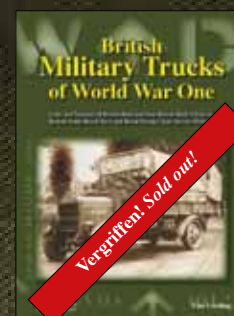
The upcoming Cold War ushered in an incredible demand for a future, potentially nuclear clash between NATO and the Warsaw Pact on European soil. The fear of World War Three made possible one of the most creative design periods in military technology ever.

The introduction of the FV numbering system additionally aimed at standardising the British military vehicle. After the war it blossomed into the idea of idealised military truck designs. The result of this heyday of military vehicle development was amazing trucks taking shape on drawing boards.

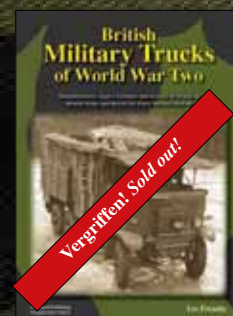

With the outbreak of World War One, Imperial Germany had been engaging with army motorisation for almost 15 years. Yet on the matter of specialised tactical military vehicles, no final design or even production had ensued. Therefore, Germany entered the war with a fleet of rear-wheel-drive civilian trucks, cars and motorcycles, with very few of them even partially militarised. There was one vital exception: for motorised anti-aircraft artillery, the crucial need for a specially designed all-wheel-drive carrier vehicle had been identified at an early stage. This publication deals in depth with, for the first time ever, the Kraftwagen-Flak motor vehicle-based anti-balloon and anti-aircraft artillery of the Kaiserreich. Lavishly illustrated with contemporary photographs, this book tells the story from pre-war prototypes through to active service during the war years, and even into the post-war Freikorps and Reichswehr periods. Zum zweiten Mal fand im Januar-Februar 1979 mit REFORGER eine Verlegeübung der amerikanischen Streitkräfte im Winter statt. Ein Übungsziel war damals, die Zuführung von amerikanischen Verstärkungen nach Europa unter extremen Wetterbedingungen zu testen und daraus Lehren für die Zukunft zu ziehen, um den Ablauf zu optimieren. Bei diesem Manöver beeinträchtigte schlechtes und unberechenbares mitteleuropäisches Winterwetter den Manöverablauf jedoch in bisher ungekanntem Maße und stellte die Führung vor eine besondere Herausforderung. Kernstück von REFORGER 79 war dabei die Korpsgefechtsübung "Certain Sentinel" im mittelfränkischen Raum. Vorliegende Publikation zeigt in eindrucksvollen Fotos den Kampf amerikanischer, deutscher und kanadischer Verbände nicht nur gegen einen kampfstarken gepanzerten Gegner auf dem Gefechtsfeld, sondern auch gegen das harsche fränkische Wetter.

REFORGER 79 was the second such exercise of US armed forces to take place in winter. One objective of the training exercise was to test the deployment of American reinforcements to Europe under extreme weather conditions, and to learn lessons for the future in order to optimise the process. Yet, poor and unpredictable Central European winter weather in January-February 1979 impaired the exercise to a hitherto unprecedented degree and presented the command with major challenges.

Core element of REFORGER 79 was the Certain Sentinel corps combat training exercise in the central Franconian region in the southern part of West Germany. This publication uses impressive exercise photographs to illustrate the fight of American, German and Canadian units against a superior armoured enemy force but also their battle against the harsh Franconian winter weather.

Die 12. (GE) Panzerdivision „Frankendivision“ mit dem Stab in Tauberbischofsheim war die letzte von insgesamt zwölf deutschen Kampfdivisionen und wurde 1961 aufgestellt. Um den Herausforderungen des nuklearen Schlachtfelds gerecht zu werden, war kurz zuvor die Heeresstruktur 2 eingeführt worden, der neue Großverband organisierte sich in der Brigadegliederung bereits danach.

Vorliegende Publikation zeichnet die außergewöhnliche Geschichte der „Frankendivision“ von 1961 bis 1994 in ausgewählten Manöverfotos der Fahrzeuge nach, die Aufnahmen stammen hierbei meist von den teilnehmenden Soldaten selbst.

12. (GE) Panzerdivision "Frankendivision", the "Franconian Division" was the last of twelve German Cold War combat divisions to be set up in 1961. It was already organised under a brigade structure according to Army Structure 2, which had been introduced to meet the challenges of the nuclear battlefield. To this end, all necessary types of troop formations were organised.

Unusually, 12. (GE) Panzerdivision was assigned the 3rd Brigade of the 1st (US) Infantry Division (Forward). In addition, 12. (GE) Panzerdivision was subordinated to VII (US) Corps in the event of a defensive scenario in accordance with the General Defense Plan. This was unique at the time, as the 12th would have been the only division of the German Army to be led and deployed by a US corps when defending against an attack by Warsaw Pact troops, and it would in turn have led a US brigade.

This publication shows the history of the Cold War "Franconian" Panzer Division from 1961-94 using impressive exercise photographs of its vehicles.

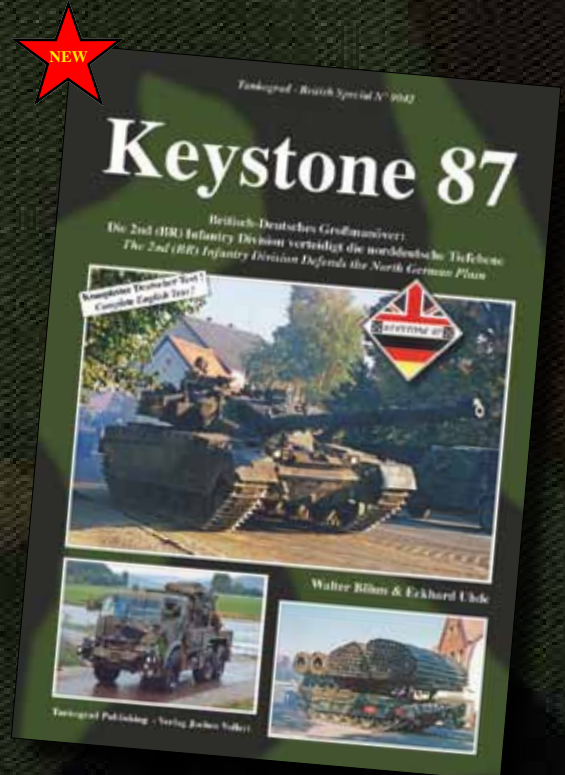
The 2nd (BR) Infantry Division Defends the North German Plain

Die 2nd (BR) Infantry Division, mit ihrem Hauptquartier in York, England, war in der Endphase des Kalten Krieges die größte britische Division und hatte eine wichtige Aufgabe: die Verstärkung der Britischen Rheinarmee im Spannungsfall. Die ersten regulären Einheiten der Division konnten bei einem bevorstehenden Angriff innerhalb von 24 Stunden auf das europäische Festland verlegt werden. Ihnen würden Einheiten der Territorial Army folgen. Die Division war spätestens nach zehn Tagen vollständig in Deutschland zur Sicherung des rückwärtigen Korpsgebiets der BAOR einsatzbereit. Dieser Spannungsfall wurde bei Keystone 87 geübt. Sowohl auf Seiten der Übungstruppe Blau als auch der von Orange fanden sich zudem kampfstärke deutsche Verbände wie die Heimatschutzbrigade 53, die Panzeraufklärungsbataillone 1 und 5 sowie das Panzerbataillon 14.

Vorliegende Publikation zeigt den bei Keystone 87 eingesetzten britischen, aber auch deutschen Fuhrpark in beeindruckenden Manöverfotos.

The 2nd (BR) Infantry Division, with its headquarters in York was the largest British division during the final stage of the Cold War. It had a critical task, reinforcement of the British Army of the Rhine in the event of war. The division's first regular units could be deployed to the European continent within 24 hours in the event of serious tension with a possible imminent attack. Territorial Army units would then follow. The division could be fully deployed to West Germany within ten days at the latest, to secure the BAOR's corps rear area. This situation was trained for during Keystone 87.

This publication shows the British and German military vehicles participating in Keystone 87 in impressive exercise photographs.



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
